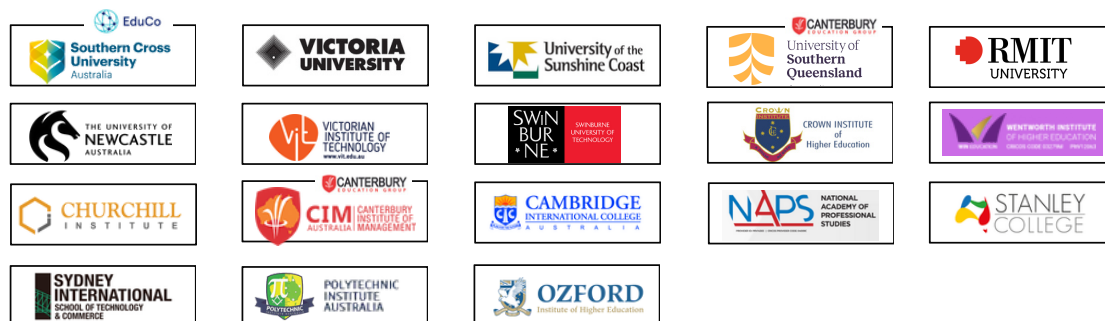

Australia

Educational Institutes and Intakes:

Universities have three intakes (Feb/July/Oct), with pathway options available three times a year (Feb/July/Oct)

Popular Programs: Engineering, IT, Business, Nursing, Education, Sciences, etc.

Minimum Requirements:

UG Degree (3/4 Yrs.) - 10+2 and IELTS 6.0.

PG Degree (2yrs) - UG Degree and IELTS 6.5

Work Opportunities: 40 hours per fortnight and full-time during vacations. 2-year

post-study work after 2 years of study, with opportunities for permanent residency.

United Kingdom

Educational Institutes and Intakes:

Known for hosting some of the oldest academic institutions in the world

Bachelor's and Master's Degrees are compact, intensive, and cost-effective compared to similar courses in other countries

Popular Programs: Business Studies, Law, Science, IT, MBA, Engineering, Biotechnology, Nursing, HRM, and Accounting & Finance

Minimum Requirements:

Undergraduate Degrees (3-4 years): 10+2 and TOEFL/IELTS/PTE

Master's Degrees (1 year): Bachelor's Degree TOEFL/IELTS/PTE.

MBA (1 year) requires a Bachelor's Degree and TOEFL/IELTS/PTE, with or without work experience. Programs available with or without an internship. Intakes are available in January and September.

Work Opportunities: 20 hours per week during term time and full-time during holidays

Ireland

Ireland is renowned for its education system and many of its universities are ranked among the top in the world.

Access to Europe: Located in Europe, Ireland provides students with easy access to other European countries, allowing for travel and exploration opportunities.

U.S.A

Academic Session: January/August with multiple intakes per year

Popular programs include Engineering, Computer Science, Business Management, Sciences, Commerce, and Arts

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate Courses (4 years): 10+2 and TOEFL 70 (IBT), IELTS 6.0, SAT (recommended for scholarships).

postgraduate Courses (2 years): TOEFL 79 (IBT), IELTS 6.5. Many universities or colleges require GRE or GMAT, but there are options without these exams as well.

Work Opportunities: 20 hours on campus per week and 12 months of Optional Practical Training (OPT). The OPT can be extended after completing studies for up to 29 months

Canada

Academic Session: Divided into three intakes: January, May, and September

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate Diplomas (2-3 years): 10+2 (50%) & IELTS 6.0

Bachelor's Degrees (3-4 years): 10+2 (60%+) & TOEFL (IBT min. 88), IELTS 6.0-6.5

Postgraduate Diplomas/Degrees (1-2 years): 15 years of education (50%+) & IELTS 6.0-6.5

Master's/MBA (1-2 years): 15/16 years of education (60%+) & IELTS 6.0-6.5

Work Opportunities: 20 hours per week while studying. Up to 3 years of open work permit after completion of education. Permanent residency opportunities under the new Canadian Experience Class. One year of post-study work experience qualifies for PR.

Japan

To study in Japan, one usually attends a Japanese language school (12-15 months) to learn the language and culture before taking the university admission exam and starting their main field of study.
